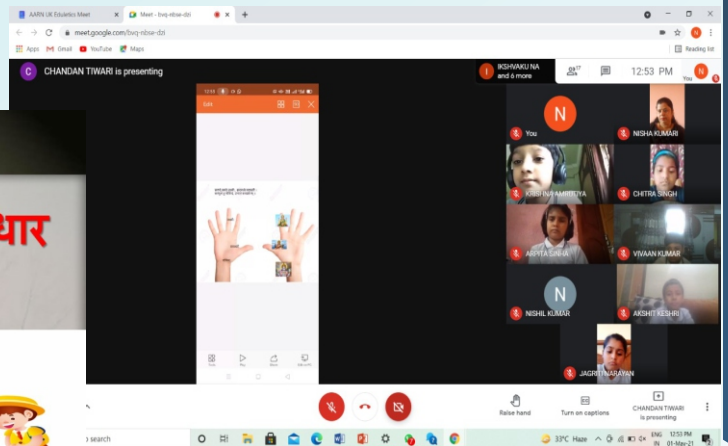
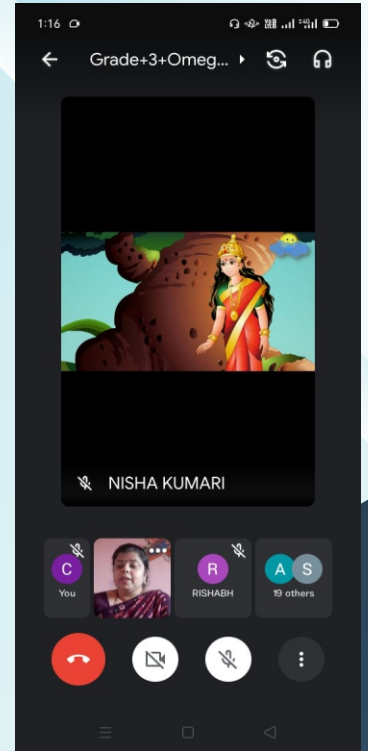
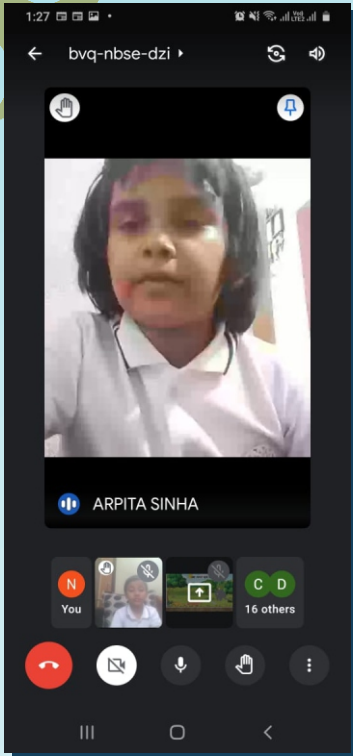

Warmer weather and better time will soon be there! With this positive approach I present to you the newsletter for the month of April 2021.

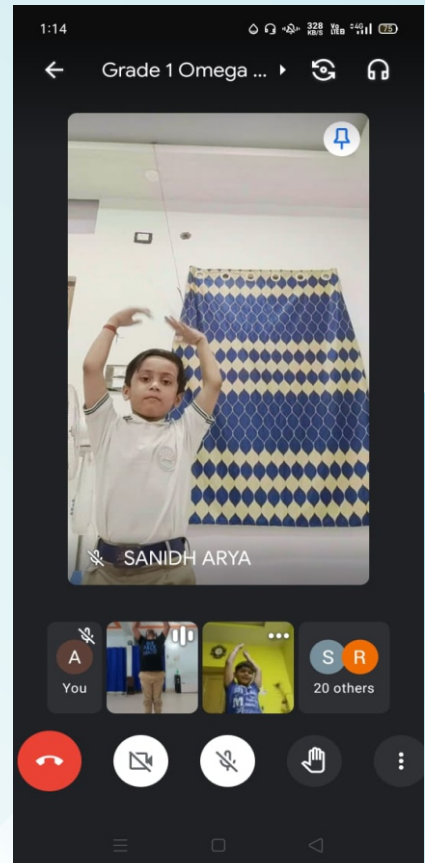
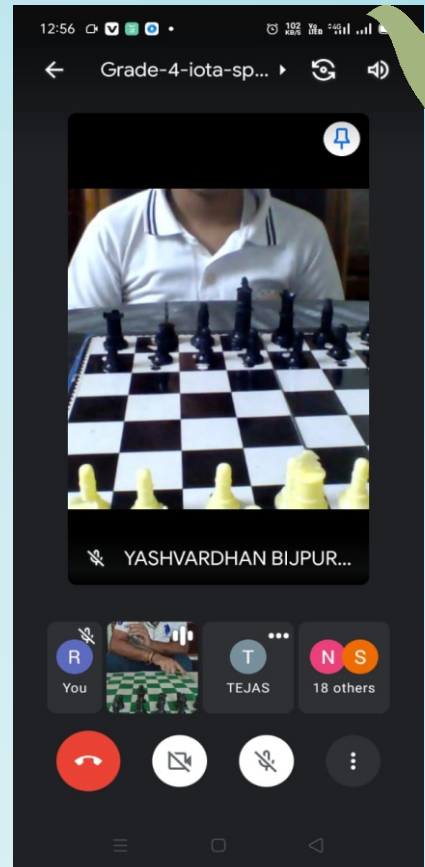
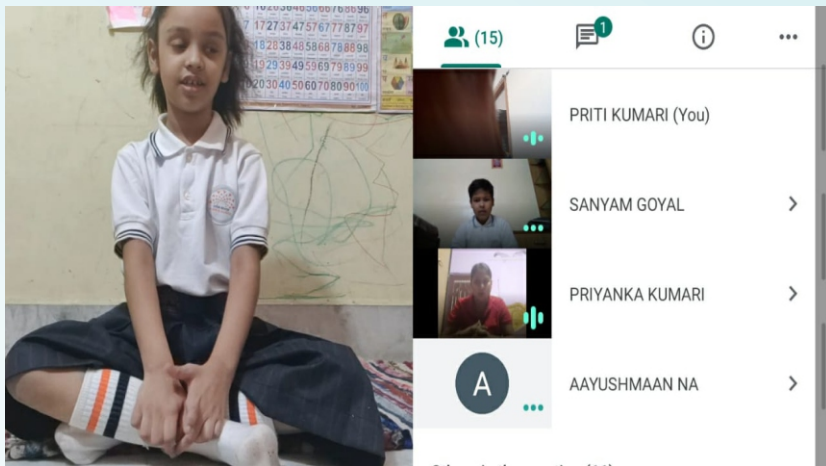
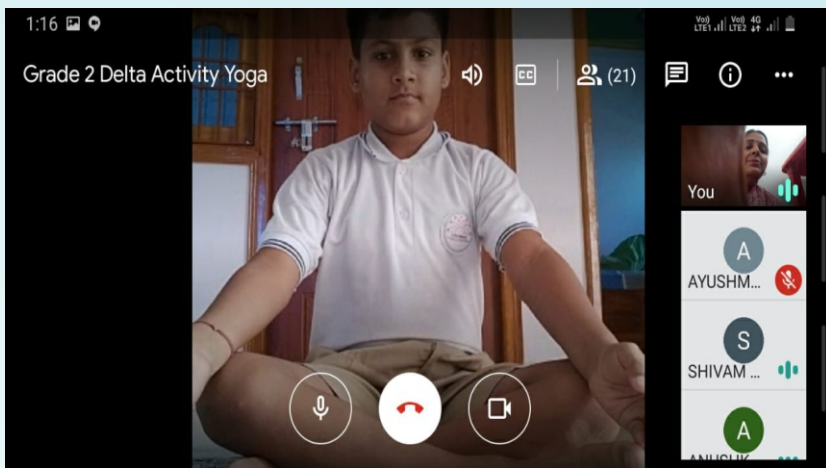
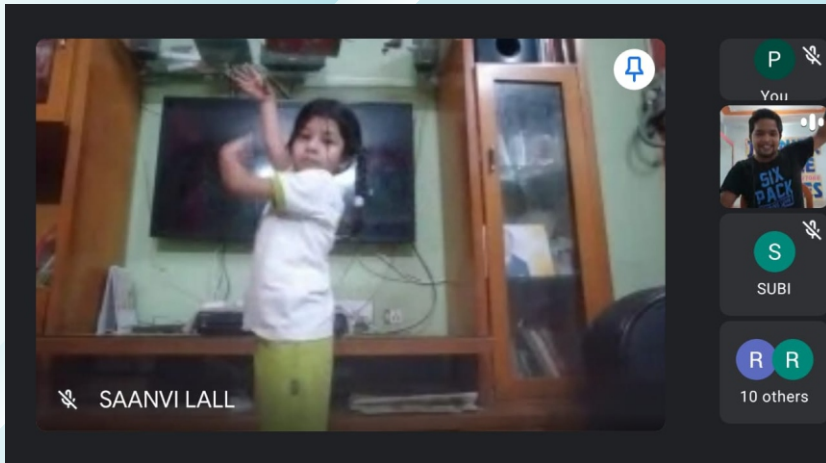
INVIGORATING VALUES AMONG STUDENTS

Little by little becomes a lot.

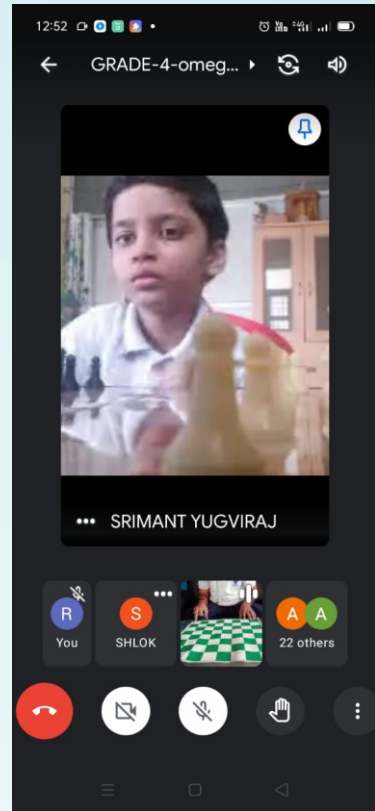
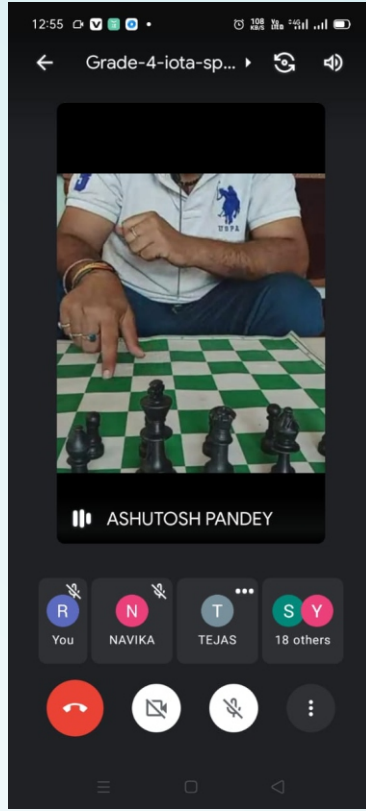
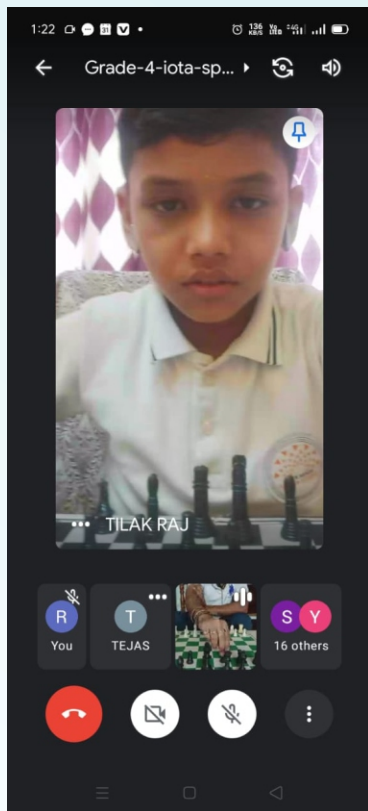
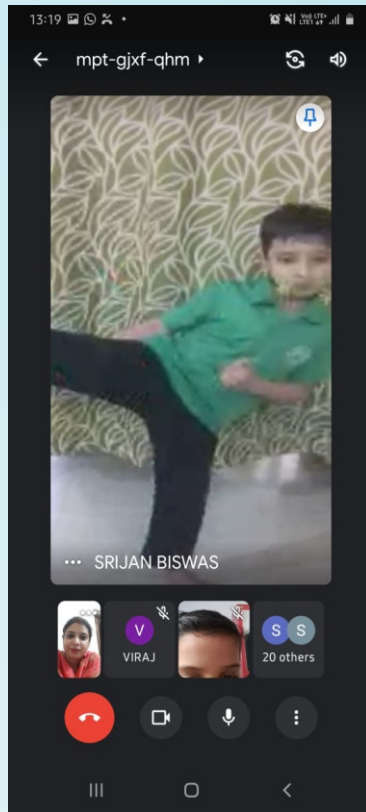
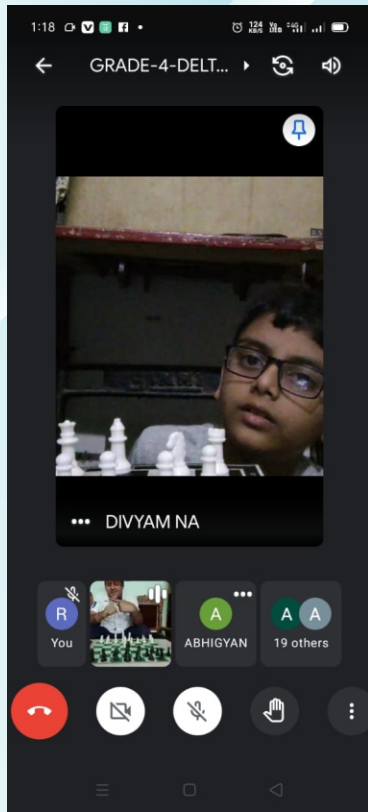
HARKENING BACK THE DEEP CHORDS OF RHYTHM AND BOUTS

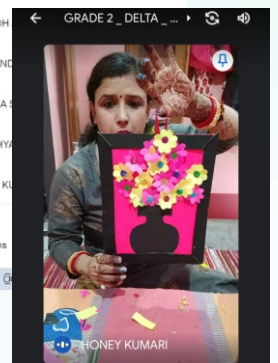
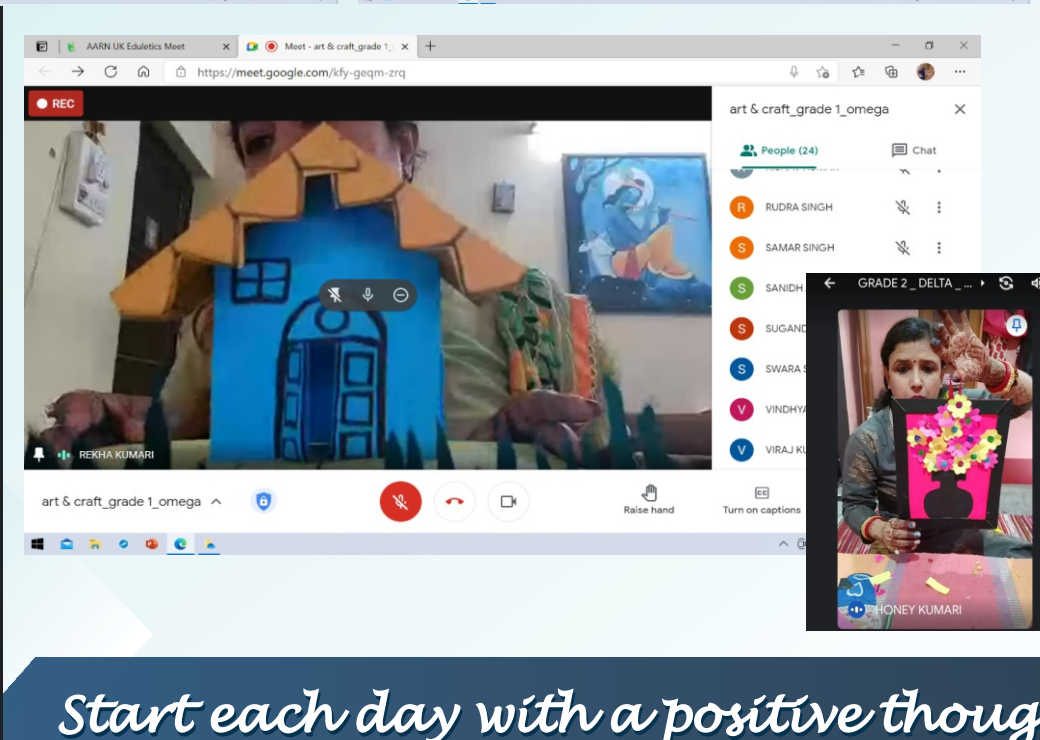
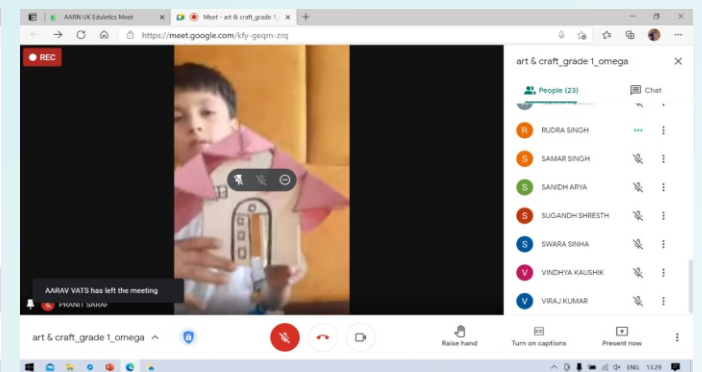
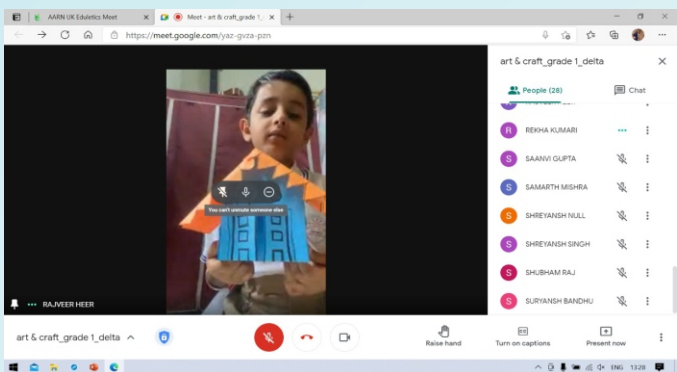
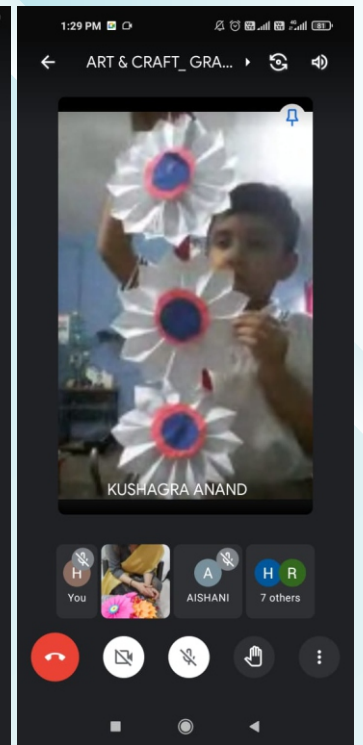
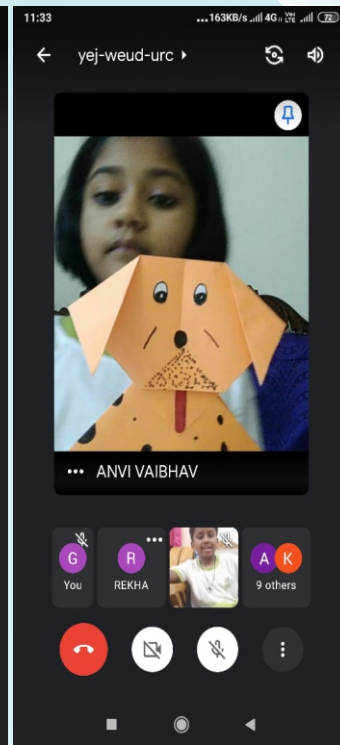
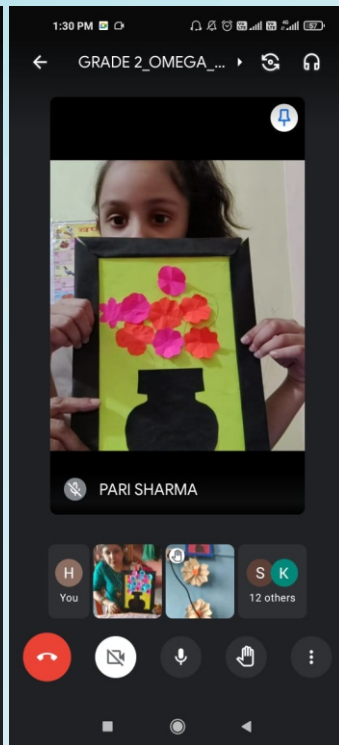
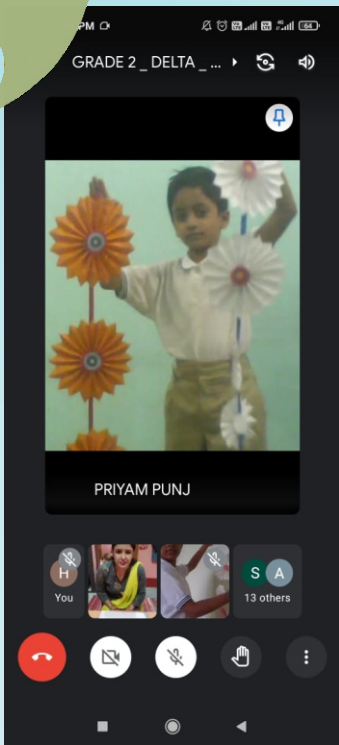
SILHOUETTING COLOURS & TASTES

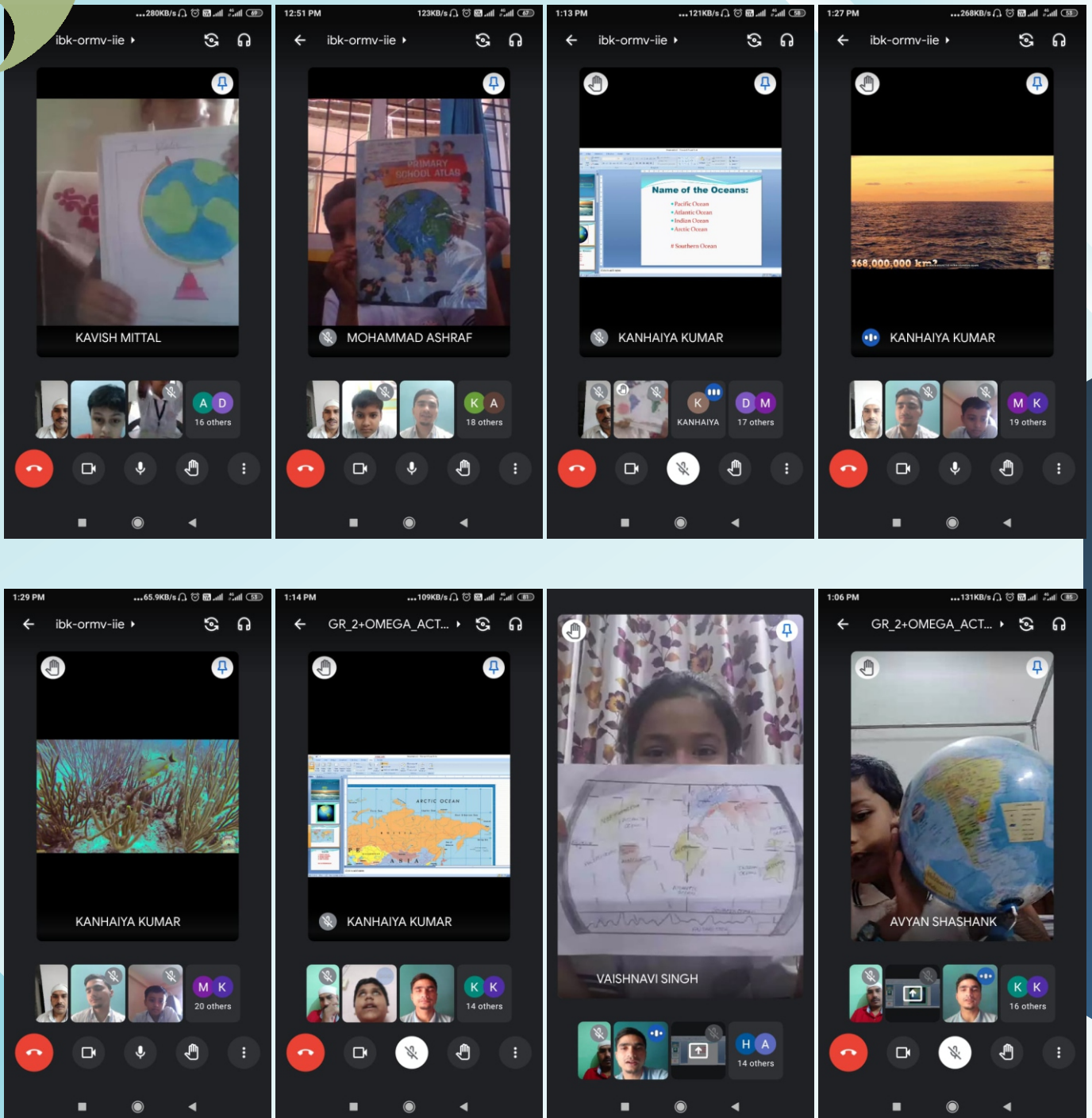
ECHOES OF CONTRIVANCE

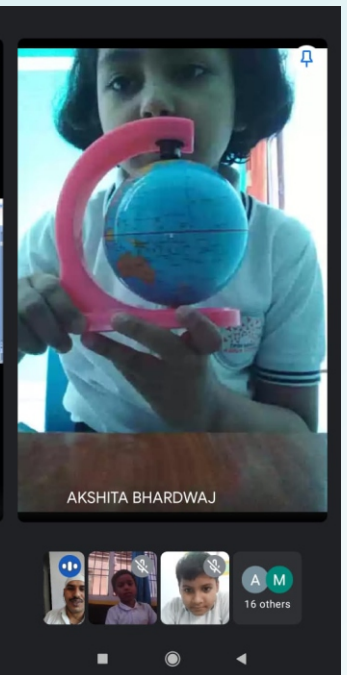
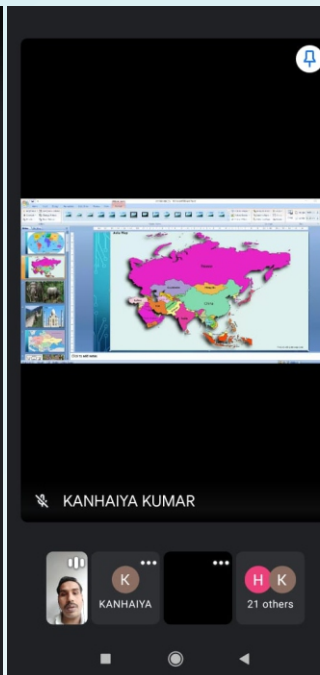
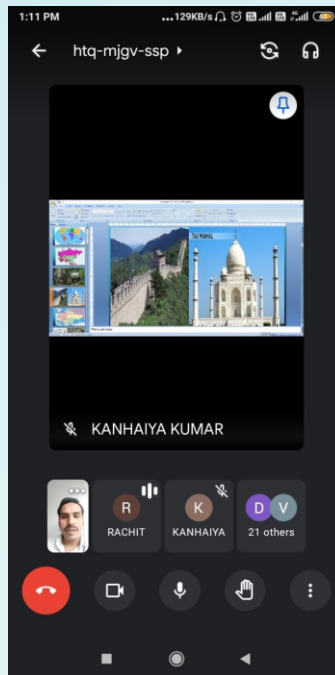
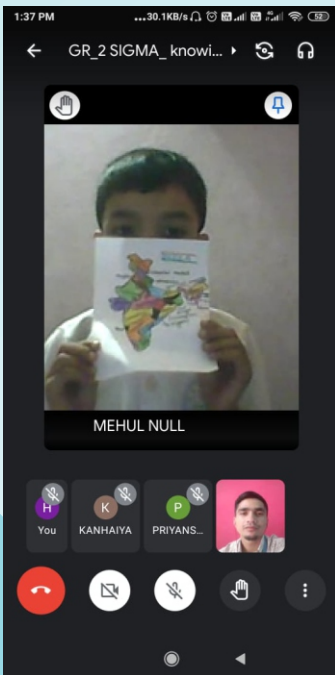
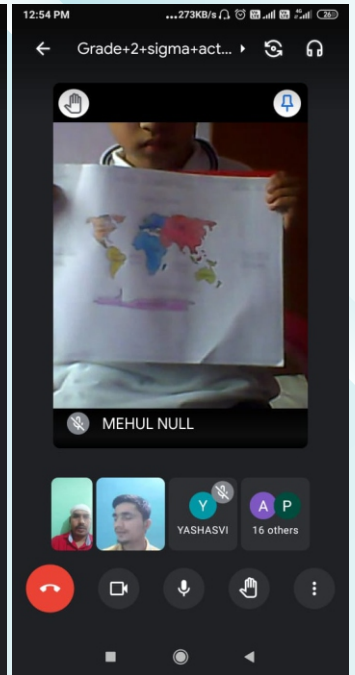
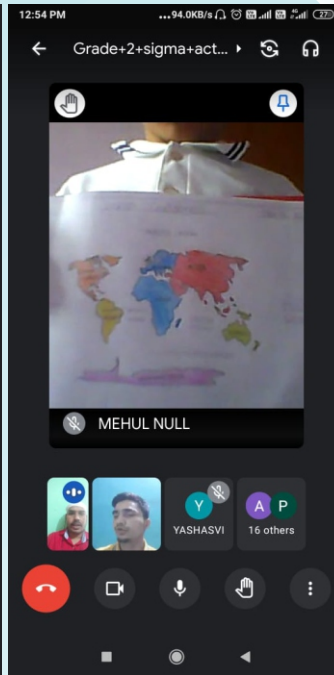
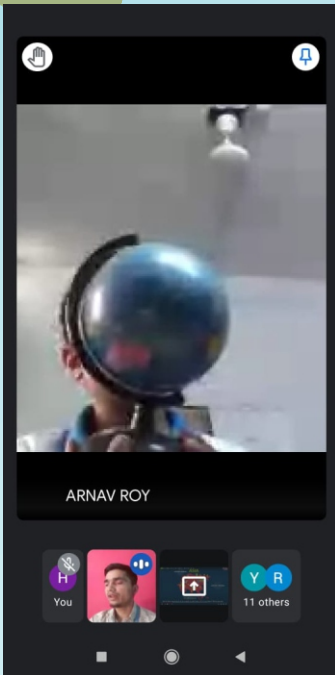
BEYOND THE BOOKS

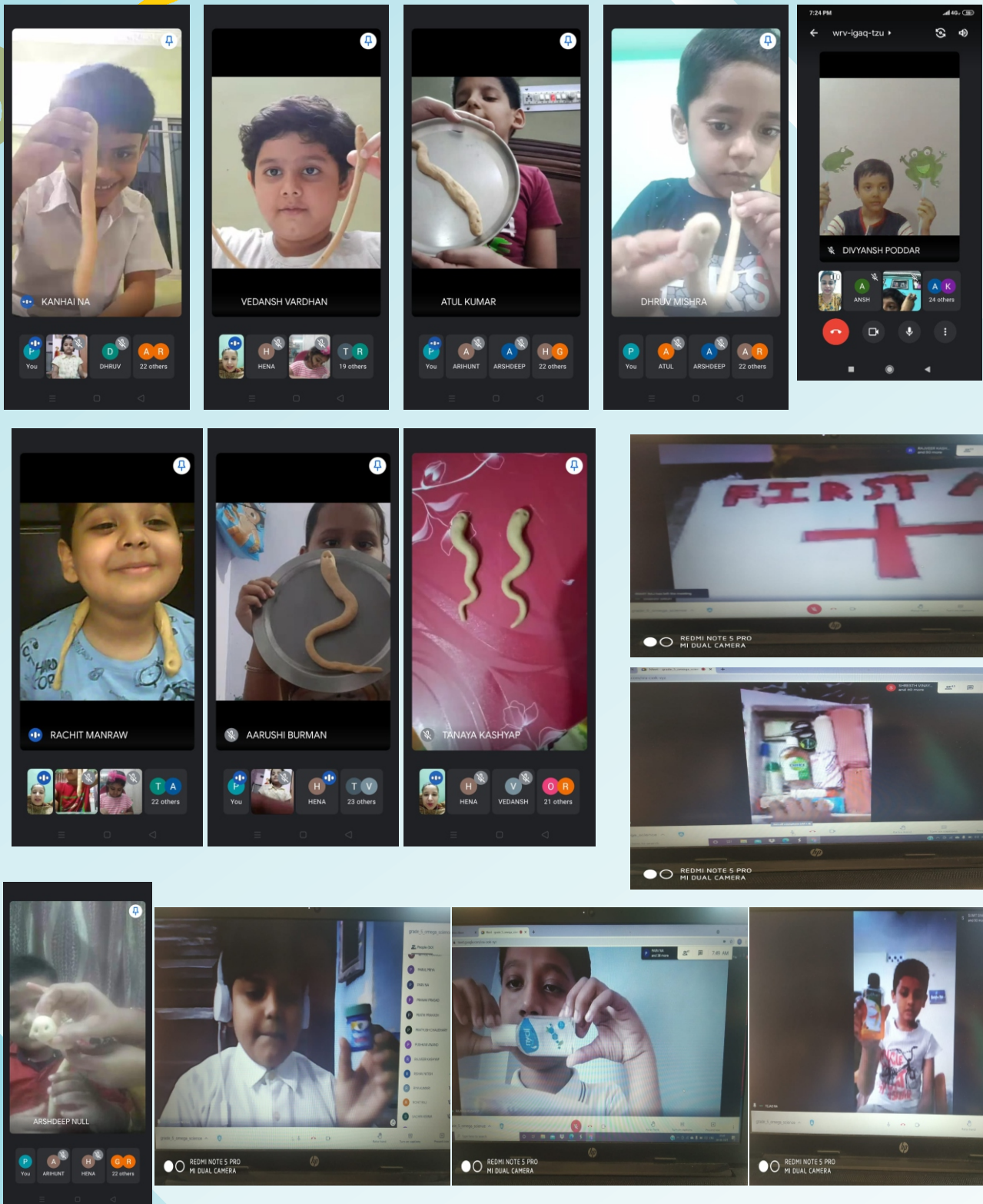
K2 ORIENTATION

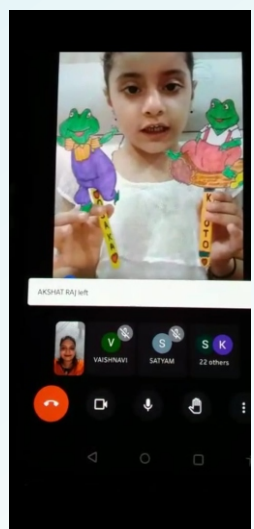
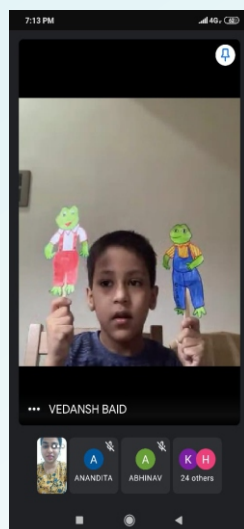
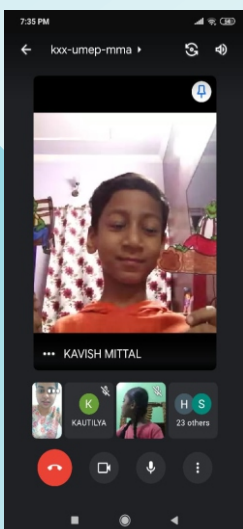
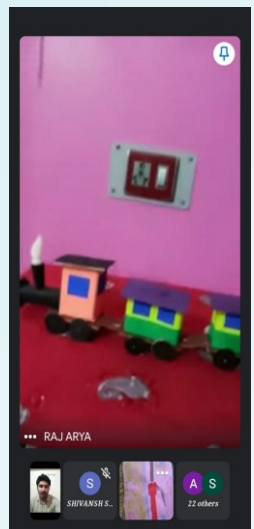
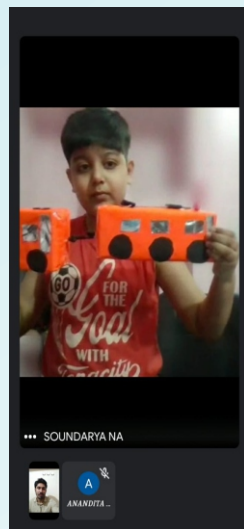
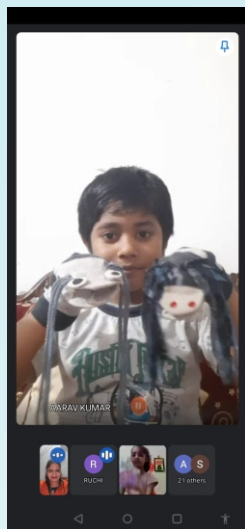
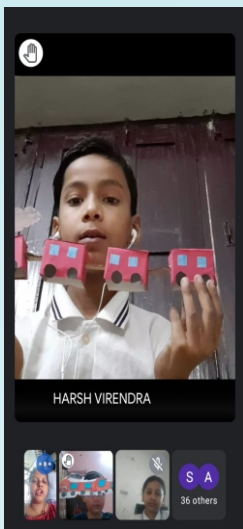
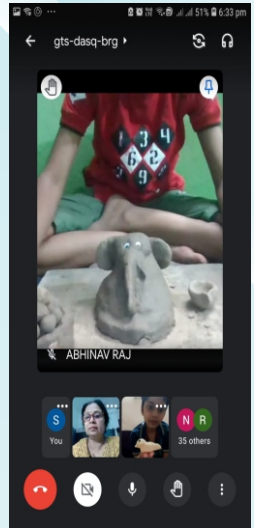
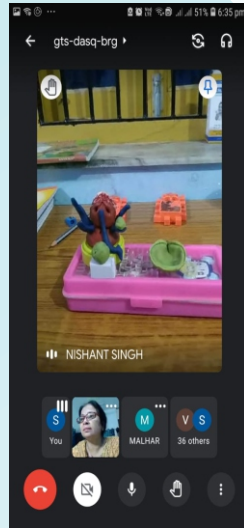
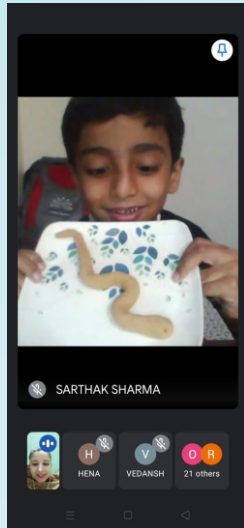
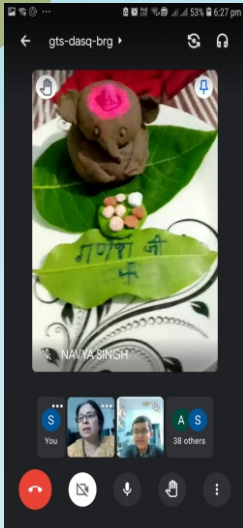
ENVISAGING SUBJECTS



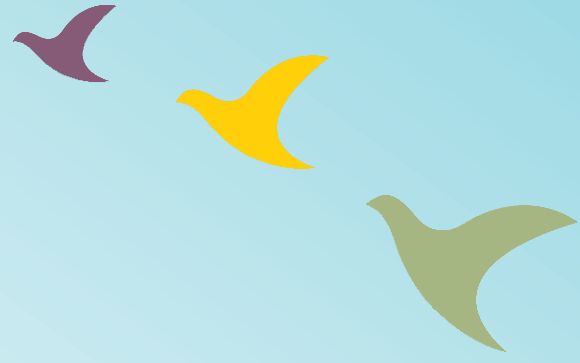

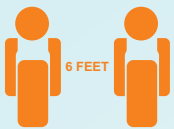
