Wishing you a delightful reading journey!




Gandhi Jayanti





In the precious moments, friendships were strengthened, and memories were forged, salting a festive tone that continued throughout the Dussehra Celebration










We feel elated to announce that the inspection of our school was done on 22nd October 2024 by the concerned authority of the State Government.


